

# Summer 2011 Financial Aid Application Information

## IWP Merit Awards

- If you receive an IWP merit scholarship (Institute, Statesman or Presidential), you are eligible to receive that award during the summer term as long as your spring term grades meet the required GPA and you enroll in 8 credits for the summer term.

## Federal Student Loans

- Federal student loans are available during the summer term to those who are enrolled at least ½ time (at least 5 credits).
- In most cases, summer 2011 federal student loans will be based on the 2010-11 academic year. Therefore, you must complete a 2010-11 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) if you have not already done so. This can be completed at <http://www.fafsa.ed.gov> IWP's school code is G41144.
- To receive a federal student loan for the summer term, you must complete a Summer 2011 and 2011-12 Loan Request Form, available on the IWP website.

## Private Student Loans

- If you will not enroll in at least 5 credits, you may be eligible to borrow a private student loan to cover your tuition and fees. Please contact me for information on private student loans.

## Summer Cost of Attendance

The cost of attendance (COA) or student budget covers the period in which you are enrolled for Summer 2011, and reflects the maximum financial aid award. Your COA is made up of tuition, fees, school related supplies, and living expenses for the period in which you are enrolled.
